

## Western Electric 300B Single Ended Limited Mono Block Amplifiers



The legendary Shindo Western Electric 300B Limited Mono Block Amplifier. Ken Shindo designed his first 300B single ended amplifier in 1979. Continually refined over the years, the WE 300B Single Limited is the flagship Shindo amplifier. Genuine NOS Western Electric 300B tubes from the original production run are employed for 8 watts Class A output. Speakers of 90db sensitivity or higher are recommended.
