The MLife is pure Momentum, right down to the core analog preamp and power amp circuits, which are essentially the same as the ones in the Momentum Integrated Amplifier. It has the same musicality-and the same effortless power, 200W into 8 Ohms, that all D'Agostino amplifiers are known for. With this amp, you can truly achieve the maximum performance your speakers are capable of, no matter what speakers you use.

The listening options are endless. You can listen to full-quality, lossless audio streamed through AirPlay, USB drives, or a network attached hard drive. You can stream from your phone or tablet via Bluetooth. And of course, you still have five analog audio inputs-feeding a pure analog, fully balanced signal path-to get the best sound from your turntable, music server, or the front left and right channels of your home theater. At the end of 2015, streaming music service, Tidal, will be added via a free software update.



An iOS app offers complete control of the **Momentum MLife Integrated Amplifier** including power, input selection, volume control, and music playback.

An Apple iPod Touch functions as the MLife's remote control and is included with every **Momentum MLife Integrated Amplifier**.

The analog circuits in the Momentum MLife Integrated Amplifier use through-hole construction, in which the contact legs of the components go all the way through the circuit board and are soldered from underneath. This technique was the norm decades ago, but it was mostly abandoned when less-expensive surface-mount construction was invented. The performance of through-hole components are superior in technical performance and reliability as compared to their surface mount counterparts.

As with all D'Agostino products, We assemble the **MLife** by hand in our Arizona factory. Every unit is fully fully tested to ensure it works perfectly and achieves the performance we demand.
